It is noted that we will be affected by an increase in traffic locally, as Farnborough increases its capacity and travellers wish to get there to make use of this. There will also be an increase in noise and pollution, from the aircraft over head. It is understood that Guildford Cathedral is used as a landmark by pilots as are the Woking Towers. As Send is situated between it is inevitable that there will be increased aircraft traffic directly over Send. Aircraft preparing to land also circle over the area. We understand that there is increasing demand for air travel. We acknowledge that the very aircraft design is quieter and far more fuel efficient and that the proposals provide benefits to the local economy. (Jobs and businesses) However we object to the extension of the operating hours to include non-weekdays, which will affect local residents and impact those within distance of the flight path in the Guildford area, as there will be additional noise and pollution.
